Safety Procedures

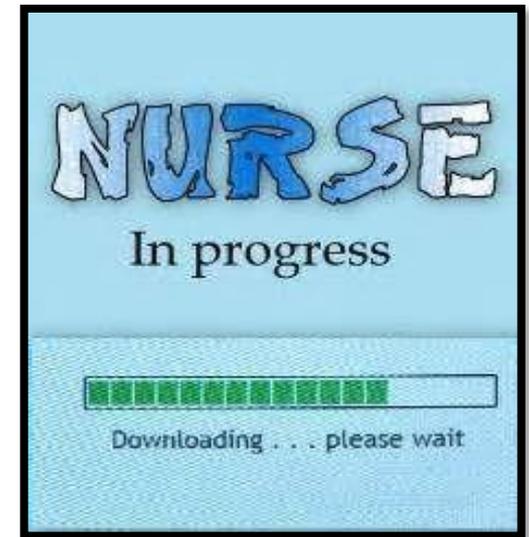
- **Fire** – take nearest exit & meet in **NORTH** parking lot.

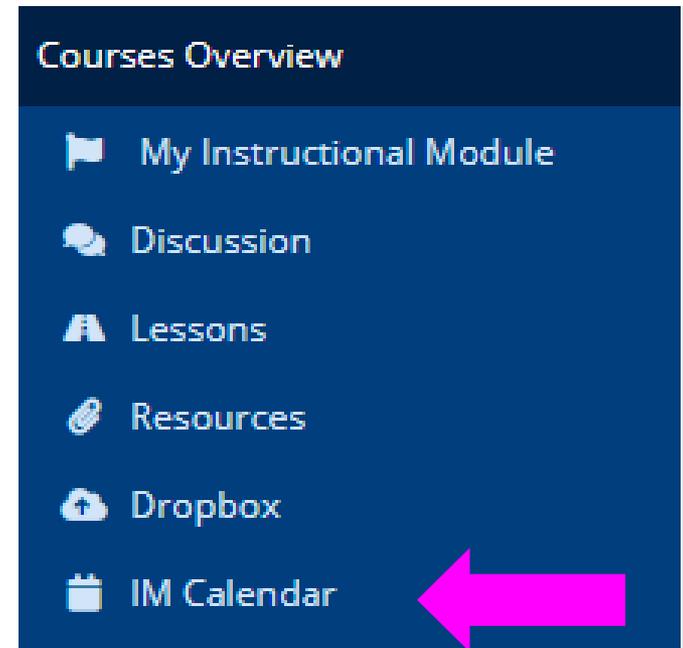
LMS – Discussion Board

- **Faculty may choose to use discussion for lecture material and class assignments**

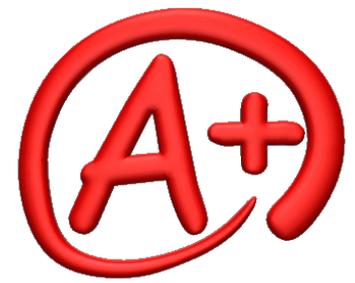


LMS - Calendar

Course Grades

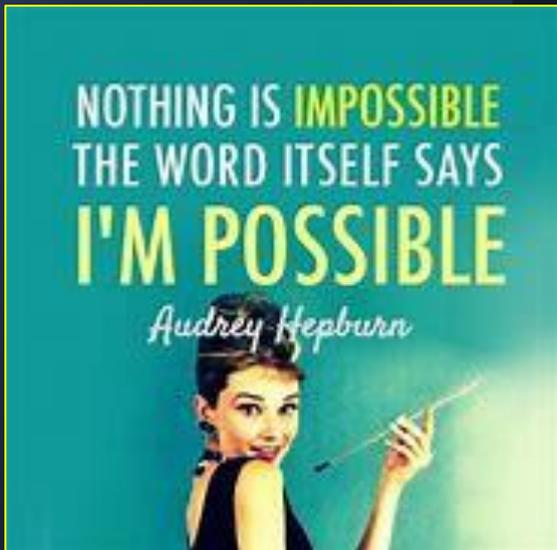
• Students to the clinical sites

- Simulation – Tues. 0830-1200 & Wed. 0830-1200

• Student Conduct

- Students employed in a healthcare role may **NOT** perform the duties of that role during CSON educational experiences.

Clinical Proficiency Exam



- **CPE** – Wk. 7 – **10% of grade**; allowed 2 attempts
 - Meet criteria on 1st attempt = 100 points
 - Meet criteria on 2nd attempt = 75 points
 - Did not meet criteria after 2 attempts = zero points
- **DO NOT** schedule work or any other activities on CPE day.
 - We cannot guarantee the time you will be dismissed
 - You may have to return in the afternoon for retakes

LATE for Classroom Activities

If late, you must notify instructor at first available opportunity.

- Attendance taken at designated start time
- Be on time - attendance is taken for every activity
- *It is possible to earn more than 1 tardy per day*

**If you are not in your chair at the designated start time,
YOU ARE TARDY!**

What is an Absence?

Student not present in theory or clinical for **more than 30 minutes after** the theory or clinical experience was scheduled to start

Student arrives on time for theory or clinical but **leaves more than 30 minutes early**

Student leaves in the middle of class/clinicals and **is gone for more than 30 minutes**, the student will be counted absent for the day.



Attendance Policy

- Review the policy in Student Handbook!
- Total of 3 absences
- **Allowed 3 absences in a module that do *not* require makeup.**
Funerals, illness, etc. are counted in the 3 days.
- Only **ONE absence from clinical will not require makeup.**
 - A **SECOND** clinical absence requires makeup.
 - **MORE THAN 2 CLINICAL ABSENCES = MODULE FAILURE.**
 - **Clinical Hours include clinical, simulation, boot camp, and CPE**
 - **Clinical absences will be counted throughout program and will be used to decide Module 8 preceptorship placement along with HESI scores and Internship.**

Reporting an Absence

- If you are going to be ABSENT/ TARDY call/text clinical/theory instructor.
 - Call in time begins **1 hour prior** to designated start time
 - In addition, **text & email Miss Starch**
- **Attendance discrepancy?**
 - Contact Miss Starch via email within 7 calendar days of attendance posting
- **Attendance Makeup Day – Week 8**



Exam day tardy/absence

- If the student arrives after the start of an exam, the student will be admitted to the exam. The student ***will receive a tardy*** & will **NOT be allowed additional time the exam.**
- **Email Miss Starch to schedule a make-up exam.**



Exam Makeup Requirements

- Missed proctored exams **must be taken on the first available day upon returning**. Day of return to school is marked by attendance to any scheduled school event during that calendar day.
- **Students may miss**
 - one (1) exam without a point deduction but will receive an absence.
 - Any subsequent exams (including standardized exams) missed during the same module will receive a 5-point deduction **and** an absence for missed class/clinical/simulation of the day.
- **If absent due to subpoenaed court appearance, funeral, approved CSON activity or deployment of close relative to active war zone will *NOT have points deducted*. Submit documentation to Miss Starch.** (see policy for details)



Attendance Policy

Clinical No Show

- Failure to notify the appropriate individual via cell phone call or text message **within 2 hours** past start time of clinical will result in **a Clinical No Show.**
 - 1 occurrence = written corrective action
 - 2 occurrences = 2 days of suspension
 - 3 occurrences = dismissal
- **Occurrences are tracked throughout the student's entire enrollment**



Inclement Weather Policy



- **If LISD delays** school on a **theory** day, CSON will delay theory classes for same amount of time as LISD
- **If LISD delays** school on a CSON **clinical** days, students may be provided asynchronous TBON approved simulated activities
- **If LISD cancels school** on a theory day, each IM will decide how & when theory content will be made up. *Options are virtual learning or the use of Fridays*
- If school is delayed or canceled on **exam day**, exams will either be delayed or rescheduled for another day
- **Everbridge** (call/text system) will be utilized for cancellation

Exams will be in the LRC

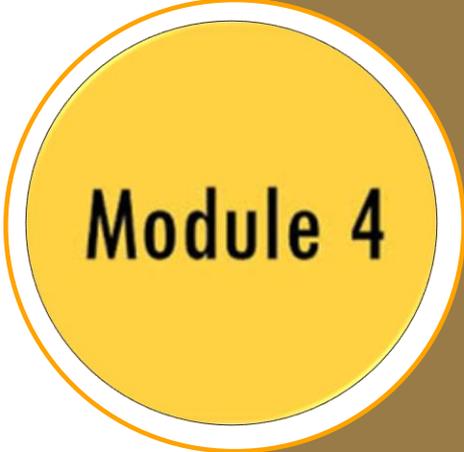
- Times of exams may vary - See course calendar
- Must have ID badge for all exams
- **Start the exam before you brain dump**
- Review will immediately follow the exam

Clarification of Exam Question or Concepts

- **Questions written on exam scratch paper NOT acceptable.**
- **You have 2 hours** after the exam closes to email instructor (no text or calls). ** 1 hour after Exam 4.**
- Provide material from textbook/lecture to support your view

Exam Procedure

- **Attendance will be taken in classroom 10 minutes prior to exam time**
 - You will be marked absent if not in your chair for attendance
 - **Do NOT** enter computer lab before exam proctor tells you to
 - You will be assigned to a computer
- All computers are now in kiosk-mode
- **CLOSE / EXIT all windows & RESTART COMPUTER before leaving**
- Return scratch paper with YOUR NAME & pencil to faculty (DO NOT BRING YOUR OWN)

Uploading Exams

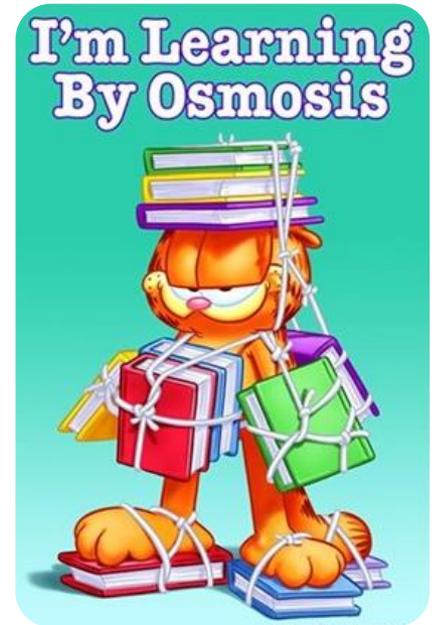
