

# IM2 Asepsis and Medication Administration SBAR\_1

## **Situation:**

Patient admitted from the ED to ICU in respiratory distress secondary to right lower lobe pneumonia. Recent exposure to TB. Presents with productive cough, shortness of breath, right side chest pain. Right Subclavian Triple Lumen Central Line (RTLSC) placed yesterday.

## **Background:**

No known drug allergies  
Type 2 diabetes mellitus  
Asthma

## **Assessment:**

- VS: BP 140/70, HR 96, R 24, T 101.2°F, SaO<sub>2</sub> 89% on room air
- Accu-data reading - 260
- Pain is 3 on numeric scale
- RTLSC - INT

## **Recommendation:**

- Perform relevant focused assessments
- Perform any indicated procedures
- Determine MEWS score
- Administer medications as indicated
