

IM2 Asepsis and IV Medication Administration SBAR_3

Situation:

Patient admitted with nausea, vomiting, diarrhea and urinary retention. Bladder scan reveals 600 mL.

Background:

- BPH
- History bradycardia
- History of Heart Failure
- Type Two Diabetes
- NKA

Assessment:

- VS: BP 102/58, HR 60, R 18, T 99.8°F, SaO₂ 94% on room air
- Pain is 5 on numeric scale
- Blood glucose 400
- Right multi-lumen subclavian IV with NS infusing at 80 mL/hr on pump
- Labs: Potassium (K⁺) 2.8; Sodium (Na⁺) 155; Magnesium (Mg⁺) 1.5

Recommendation:

- Perform any relevant focused assessments
- Administer medications as indicated
- Perform any indicated procedures
- Determine MEWS score
