1. What did you observe during the day? Were there any specific procedures that were able to participate in or observe? Mostly FHR auscultation and a nonstress test. The physician performed Cervical exams, Pap smears, GBS tests, and ultrasounds but I was not present for those. I personally took a ton of manual BPs and performed auscultation of the FHR using a doppler. Also just a ton of education took place.

2. What was the best/most interesting part of the experience?

I got to use the doppler on a 16 wk pregnancy and got it first try. It was cool to see the variability in fetal heart in the abdomen and use that knowledge.

*Also, after taking her moms BP, a little girl gave me a thumbs up so that was pretty cool.
