BACKGROUND



- ⊕ Dallas Regional Medical Center, Mesquite, Texas
- ⊕ Positioned for two years and six months
- ⊕ August 29, 2019
- ⊕ Remedial courses



EVENTS

- ➕ The patient who was 33 weeks pregnant was first admitted to the Emergency Department with complaint of chest and abdominal pain
 - ➕ Transferred to the Labor and Delivery Unit for observation placed in the respondents care
 - ➕ The patient started to decline rapidly
 - ➕ The patient was hypotensive, lethargic drooling, difficult to arouse and unable to maintain an airway

EVENTS CONT..

- ⊕ Failure to call Rapid Response Team, patient was intubated and given two units of blood in the Emergency Department
- ⊕ Resulting in emergency C-Section, diagnosing the patient with complete uterine rupture


Despite resuscitation efforts, the infant was pronounced dead

- ⊕ Patient was transferred to the ICU
- ⊕ The patient was stable and discharged home





! PREVENTION !

- ⊕ Critical Thinking Skills
- ⊕ Provide mechanisms to maintain the patients airway
- ⊕ Thorough assessment completed on the patient



UNIVERSAL COMPETENCIES




Critical Thinking: The respondent failed to use her critical thinking skills by failing to call for Rapid Response.

Communication: Failed to communicate the patients declining status.


Safety and Security: Respondent violated the patients safety by not keeping the patient and the baby safe.

Professional Role: The respondent failed to provide professional nursing skills regarding the patients care.

- ⊕ Notify Charge Nurse and Provider
 - ⊕ Provide further assessments and interventions on the patient
 - ⊕ Call for Rapid Response Team
 - ⊕ Discussion with the respondent
