## Instructional Module 6: Obstetrics Community Clinical Experience

Community Site: Dr. Blann's office

1. What did you observe during the day?

Were there any specific procedures that were able to participate in or observe? Today I was able to observe what it was like to work in a OB clinic. I saw many women come in for ultrasounds, fetal heart tones, or even for postpartum depression management. Specific procedures that I participated in, included getting every patient manual blood pressure and finding all the fetal heart tones on each mom.

One of the most interesting parts of the experience was learning how to navigate the Doppler and deciphering from mom's heartbeat to the fetal heart.

Community nursing is very important, one day in the future I do believe I would consider working in a clinic because I currently work in a clinic now. The hours are very different as is the workflow versus a hospital.

I do believe that this community site meets the needs of the population. They serve because they were able to come in and ask for all the information that they need regarding pregnancy or contraception or even postpartum depression and how to manage that.

Majority of the patient teaching that I saw was about contraception after pregnancy. Moms would come in ask about the mini pill and whether they should use it during breast-feeding. Other moms came in wanting a contraception that did not have any hormones in it. I feel like the certified medical assistant knew and gave as much information as she could to educate the moms however, there were a few times where I felt a Registered nurse would be able to explain education on each contraceptive methods they offered, and what they do for the body.
