


What is happening in the body?

a hole in the abdominal wall at the umbilical cord where the intestines and possibly other organs are protruding




What am I going to see during my assessment?

abdominal organs outside the body. This infant had already had surgery, so she had a small dressing over the site.



What tests and labs will be ordered?

possible blood work to check for infection; make sure baby is stable for surgery; over time, baby will be evaluated for bottle feeding (suck, swallow, breathe)



What trends and findings are expected?

infant may have a harder time with thermoregulation
