| Lisinopril | ACE inhibitor | Treats HTN | 1.5mg PO once daily | Yes Choose an item. Click here to enter text. | Click here to enter text. | Rash, HA, dizziness, nausea, weakness, chest pain | 1. Assess for edema and auscultate lungs frequently 2. I&Os and Daily weights 3. Monitor kidney function and potassium levels 4. slowly rise when transitioning from sitting to standing or lying to sitting |
| Ampicillin | penicillins | Treat infections caused by bacteria | 181mg IV Q6hrs | Yes Choose an item. Click here to enter text. | Click here to enter text. | Fever, itching, rash, nausea, abd pain, "hairy" tongue | 1. Monitor liver function 2. check IV site carefully for signs of thrombosis or allergic reaction 3. Eat frequent small meals to avoid the abd pain and GI upset 4. Report any unusual bleeding or severe |

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
