**Instructional Module 6: Obstetrics Community Clinical Experience**

Community Site: Women's Health Clinic

1. What did you observe during the day? Were there any specific procedures that were able to participate in or observe?

I observed several patients from various ages presenting with different chief complaints. I observed Winn perform a pap smear, look for a FHR w/ a doppler, vaginal swab, and provide pt. education. In addition, I took vital signs on patients as they were coming in.

2. What was the best/most interesting part of the experience?

Visualizing the pap smear and seeing the cervix was interesting. In addition, I learned about the different types of birth control available. I expanded my learning by observing different patients and what kind of nursing interventions are needed.

3. Is a community nursing position something that you would consider working in? Why or why not?

I would consider working as a community health nurse in the future. However, I would rather establish my nursing foundation first, so I can know what proper interventions/education can benefit each patient.

Nurse Winn & Callie provided excellent patient teaching. From taking the time to explain procedures to recommending/demonstrating birth control insertion (IUD & Novaring). I believe W.H.C. provided great patient teaching.

**Safety & Quality:**

Handwashing, cleaning rooms between each patient and identifying patients (DOB, Name, allergies)

**Clinical Judgment:**

Nurses used clinical judgment by requesting certain procedures (i.e. ultrasound) to determine reproductive issues.

**Patient Centered Care:**

Actively listen to patient's presenting complaint & creating a therapeutic relationship to enhance patient care.

**Professionalism:**

Placing the patient's well being & promoting comfort first (i.e. finding a room w/ an exam chair & providing privacy)

**Communication & Collaboration:**

Both nurses demonstrated communication by providing patient education. Collaboration is effective as both nurses worked with patients & referrals to proper doctors / clinics (i.e. plastic surgery / neuro)
