






Pediatric Congenital Heart Defects

Defects that cause ***increased pulmonary blood flow*** due to abnormal connections between the great arteries, allowing blood flow from the higher pressure on the left side of the heart to the lower pressure on the right side of the heart.



Acyanotic - Obstruction to blood flow from the ventricles due to narrowing (stenosis). The pressure in the ventricle and the great artery **before the obstruction is increased**, and the pressure in the area past **the obstruction is decreased**. The narrowing is usually near the valve.






