POST-CLINICAL REFLECTION OB Simulation Reflection - due on Thursday by 2359

To strengthen your clinical judgment skills, reflect on your knowledge and the decisions made caring for this patient by answering the reflection questions below.

Reflection Question	Nurse Reflection
What feelings did you experience in clinical? Why?	I was a little overwhelmed during my scenario because I was not sure how I was supposed to prioritize my plan of care, but then I felt more confident in my prioritization throughout my scenario.
What did you already know and do well as you provided patient care?	I knew that I needed to administer Clindamycin because my patient was positive for GBS, and I felt like I provided education to enhance my care for my patient.
What areas do you need to develop/improve?	I need to improve my oxytocin medication administration because I did not titrate the amount correctly during the scenario.
What did you learn today?	I learned that you need to titrate oxytocin slowly to prevent fetal distress.
How will you apply what was learned to improve patient care?	I will watch the fetal heart monitor closely to identify any decells or other signs of fetal distress when giving the patient oxytocin. This will improve the patient's outcome by preventing harm to the baby.

Safety & Quality- I learned that it is important to increase the rate of Oxytocin slowly to prevent fetal distress.</p> <p>2. Clinical Judgment- I showed an understanding of clinical judgment by noticing that the FHR monitor was showing signs of decells, and I knew that I needed to intervene with intrauterine resuscitation to restabilize the baby.</p> <p>3. Professionalism- I was professional by advocating for my patient to receive pain medication during labor because her husband was trying to prevent her from getting any medication for pain.</p>

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
