

## Charge 1: March 7, 2013

- Failed to document the waste of unused narcotics

## **Charge 2: April 11, 2013 and April 12, 2013**

### 1. Specific observations:

- Slurred speech
- Stumbling while walking
- Inability to stay focused on a task
- Eyes remained closed during conversation

**Charge 2: April 11, 2013 and April 12, 2013**


## 2. Potential Impact

- Compromised ability to observe patient status or changes
- Impaired judgment and assessment skills
- Risk to patient safety and quality of care

# Timeline of Events

## Charge 3: April 12, 2013

- Urine specimen that tested positive for Barbiturates



# Measures to Prevent Action and Promote Safe Practice

## Charge 1

- Situation could have been avoided if Sandra properly wasted and documented the narcotics
- Patient wasn't harmed, as correct dose was given and documented

# Measures to Prevent Action and Promote Safe Practice

## Charge 2 and 3

- Charge 2 was likely due to barbiturate exposure
- Both Charges could've been prevented by:
  - Not taking barbiturates
