Instructional Module 6: Obstetrics Community Clinical Experience

Community Site: City of Lubbock Health – STD Clinic

1. What did you observe during the day? Were there any specific procedures that were able to participate in or observe?

I observed vaginal exams, pharyngeal exams, thorough sexual history questionnaires, IM medications being administered, and lots of charting. I observed skin assessments for syphilis rashes and external and internal assessments of the penis and vagina. I observed patient teaching for medications and importance of follow up appointments. I observed testing for syphilis, trichomonas, HIV, and bacterial vaginosis. I observed a wet prep being prepared. I observed clue cells, sperm, and bacterial vaginosis under the microscope.

I drew blood for various tests. I performed the WHIFF test, which was positive for the “fishy” smell. I performed a pregnancy test, which was negative. I performed a pharyngeal swab for syphilis. I performed HIV tests. I administered IM injections. I reconstituted Ceftriaxone and administered it. I assisted in obtaining cervical mucus. I cleaned the examination rooms and prepped them for the next patient and screen testing.

2. What was the best/most interesting part of the experience?
I think the most interesting part of my day was that I anticipated having patients that were much younger. I was surprised.
3. Is a community nursing position something that you would consider working in? Why or why not?
I do not believe I am called to this position. I do not feel that I would do it justice.

4. Do you feel like this community site met the needs of the population they serve? Why or why not?
 Yes, I believe this community site meets the needs of the population they serve. They also go out into the community to assist those who may not want to come into the clinic for testing. They also distribute free condoms to them in attempts to decrease the spread of STIs.

5. Did you witness patient teaching? What general things were taught to this population? Do you feel that patient teaching in this community site was adequate? Why or why not?
 Yes. The general things they taught were that treatment is necessary to get rid of syphilis and that its imperative that your partners are tested and treated too. The medications need to be taken as prescribed so they can be effective. If your partner(S) fail to be tested and treated, they will continue to reinfect you repeatedly. Condoms can help the spread of some STI's, not all. Yes, I feel it was adequate, but the education being heeded is another story.
