CSON IM2: Scoring Rubric for Disciplinary Action Summary Presentation

Powerpoint must be turned into Dropbox by midnight the day before or a point deduction will occur.

- Up to 24 hours late: 15-point deduction

- Cases that do not directly impact patient care (instances during personal life, occurrences outside hospital or clinic work hours, charges for not paying student loans, etc.)
