

CSON IM2: Scoring Rubric for Disciplinary Action Summary

Assignments submitted after the deadline will receive a point deduction on top of their grade using the below rubric.

- **Up to 24 hours late: 15-point deduction**

Case must be:

- Registered Nurse
- Involves charges related to patient care **IN A HOSPITAL OR CLINIC SETTING** (med errors, patient safety, drug diversion, patient abandonment, etc.)

Case may not be:

- LVN, NP, APRN, etc.
- Cases that do not directly impact patient care (instances during personal life, occurrences outside hospital or clinic work hours, charges for not paying student loans, etc.)
