1. **Question:** List at least three common complications of diabetes and briefly describe the signs and symptoms associated with each.

2. **Case Study:** Imagine you are assessing a patient with diabetes. Write down two signs or symptoms you would look for that might indicate a complication is developing. Explain why these signs are significant.

3. **Critical Thinking:** Why is it crucial for nurses to recognize the signs and symptoms of diabetes complications early? Write two to three sentences discussing the potential impact on patient outcomes.

4. **NCLEX Question:** Write 3 NCLEX questions pertaining to recognizing signs and symptoms of complications of diabetes. The question needs to be a multiple-choice question with one correct answer and several distractors. Please be prepared to have a detailed rationale for each answer, explaining why it is correct and why the other options are incorrect. Email me your questions so we can display them in class.
