	Labs and diagnostics:	CBC with differential and basic metabolic panel—all labs normal. Urine drug screen positive for marijuana. HcG negative.
Assessment	Nurse's assessment:	Tessa has been attempting to split staff by making derogatory comments towards nursing staff then apologizing for her behaviour. She is requesting special privileges to smoke. No evidence of infection related to wrist lacerations. Reports that acetaminophen given at 0600 reduced pain to 2 from a level of 6. Cuts on wrists and show no evidence of infection. She slept 6 hours last night.
