Vancomycin	125mg PO q6h for 10 days		Severe Bacterial Infection -C.diff -enterocolitis/staph -pneumonia -endocarditis -Anthrax -MRSA -meningitis	-Do NOT use while pregnant. (BBW) -Can cause ototoxicity, please let me know if you experience hearing loss. -Can cause intestinal inflammation, let me know if you have pain in the abdominal region. -You need to finish the course of the antibiotic. If you do not finish the antibiotic, it can cause a superinfection due to not clearing the original infection.
Metoprolol	50 mg PO Bid		-HTN -Angina -MI -atrial fibrillation	-This medication lowers blood pressure. Always call so I can help you if you need to get up. -This medication can cause n/v/d. -In severe cases this medication can cause severe bradycardia. -Do not stop this medication abruptly.
Prednisone	5 mg PO		-corticosteroid – responsive conditions -asthma -gout	-This medication can cause abdominal discomfort and appetite changes. Please let me know if you experience this. -It can cause fluid retention, weight gain, edema. -If you develop a rash that you did not have before, please let me know.

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				-In severe cases you can have an allergic reaction to this medication.
Ondansetron	4mg PO		-Nausea and vomiting	-Please let me know if you develop a headache or fatigue. -Constipation can occur while taking this medication. -Anaphylaxis may occur while taking this medication. -While taking this medication always call if you need to get up, you may experience dizziness.
Levofloxacin	750mg PO		-Pneumonia -UTI -skin infections	-Tendinitis/tendon rupture may occur. (BBW) -N/V/D may develop. -Headache and dizziness are common symptoms from taking this medication. -Take the whole prescription of this antibiotic if not you may develop a super infection.
