We were able to have meaningful conversation regarding the use of condoms to protect against STI's with a patient we also provided him condoms to use after his treatment of doxycycline for 28 days. He was also advised to come back in 7 months for further testing.

There was a patient that tested positive for Syphilis and had a rash on his shoulders, trunk, & genital area. He stated that he like to "pick at his sores." We advised him that picking could lead to further infection and spread. He was also given doxycycline for a 14 day treatment and was advised to come back in 6 months.
