

HESI Scoring Information

The RN Specialty Exams provide essential data regarding a student's mastery of concepts in relation to specific nursing content areas. The proctored HESI RN Specialty Exam outcomes will be used in final Instructional Module grade calculations if the student qualifies for progression by achieving a 75% average on unit exams. Cumulative results are also used in the determination for the IM8 capstone placement. The expected level of achievement for the HESI RN Specialty Exams is a HESI score of 850.

Version 1 Exams:

Students earning a HESI score of 850 or above on V1 exams will earn 100% in the gradebook. Those students who do not meet benchmark on the first attempt will be required to complete a remediation packet prior to taking the V2 exam.

Version 2 Exams:

Upon completion of the remediation packets, which are *due 12/04 @ 2359*, the student will be allowed to take the 2nd version of the HESI Proctored Exam *on 12/08*

Students having to take the V2 HESI exam(s) will receive the **conversion score in the gradebook regardless if the HESI score is 850 or greater.**
