

## HESI Categories for Proctored Exams

Practice Tests and Practice Quizzes are located in the Case Studies Folder  
It is **STRONGLY** recommended to complete those in preparation for your Proctored exam

### Scoring:

- Students earning a HESI score of 850 or above on **V2 Exams** will earn 100% in the gradebook. Students with a score of 849 or less will be **required to complete structured remediation prior to taking the second version of the HESI exam** (see course calendar). Due date for V1 remediation will be **12/04/25 @ 2359**
- If the benchmark is not met on V1, remediation of V1 and completion of V2 exam is required. Failure to complete both versions will result in module failure.

V1 Sample	HESI Score	Conversion score	Gradebook Score
Student 1	1030	92.35	100%
Student 2	876	80.66	100%
Student 3	839	74.88	74.88%
Student 4	703	63.25	63.25%

- If a student fails to complete the remediation of V1, the student will be unable to take V2 and will receive an absence. (See Theory Exam/Quiz or Standardized Test Absence)
- The **conversion score on the V2 exam will be placed in the gradebook and account for 5% of the course grade.**
- Example: (Conversion Scores vary based on exam-type and student performance)

V2 Sample	HESI Score	Conversion score
Student 1	1030	92.35
Student 2	876	80.66
Student 3	839	74.88
Student 4	703	63.25

- Students who are unsuccessful in meeting V2 benchmark will be highly encouraged to complete remediation before 12/11 to aid in preparing for later modules and NCLEX.
