


OB LAB INFORMATION:

Review the following information for your clinical assignment.


Pre-Work should already have been completed and submitted.

Should you have questions about paperwork, you can ask during instructional time.

Make sure you look at the Lab Schedule to ensure you are in the 1300 or 1500 group.



- In **Mrs. Nuttall's** room we will practice the following skills for a refresher on how to insert a *urinary catheter*, *drawn blood* or *started an IV*.
- These skills will most likely be done in any of the OB sites.
- You will have a very good chance of performing these skills in this module during your clinical experiences.



- In **Mrs. Soliz's** room we will review what you need to know for your CPE. I know it is early in the module and more than likely you will forget what it mentioned today so a CPE reminder will be sent later in the module prior to CPE day.
- We will practice with the pumps in this room as well, so you have hands-on practice with pump itself, performing a Bolus, & administering a piggyback med
- We will review your pre-work and discuss any areas you may need on the following: injection sites, toco placement, syringe/needles and writing

OB LAB INFORMATION:

Clinical Need to Know Information by Site

OB SIM:

- You will attend with Mrs. Soliz and meet in debrief room and we will begin at 0800.
- You have pre-work (pages 1-3 of your pt assignment) that is to be submitted to *OB Simulation Dropbox* on the patient that is assigned to you.
- Be prepared to participate in all aspects of SIM and be active in briefings. We will have breaks throughout the day in SIM as well as lunch. We will do a brief practice scenario as a group then we will move onto assigned scenarios.
- Watch orientation video in LMS of room so you are aware of where items are in the patient room. With this being a larger group, it is expected you prepare yourself best you can so we can begin scenarios promptly after practice run.
- You will do an SBAR report on your patient after your care.
- A reflection will need to be completed as well as part of your weekly clinical paperwork along with the remaining pages (pg. 4-5) of your pt assignment.
- SLO examples can be provided on your reflection sheet.

COMMUNITY SITES:

- Ensure you know where you are going ahead of time; look at the times and address prior
- Call the site the day before you attend to inform the staff that you will be at their site the following day. If they want you to come in a little earlier or later, that is fine. (If you are attending these sites, you **DO NOT** have to call the day before: NSY, AP, or PE.)
- Complete assigned paperwork and verification form signed
- Upload verification form into Dropbox (*OB Verification Form*)
- Upload questions into Community Form Dropbox
- If absent, you will call that day of within 2 hours of the start time and inform the site of your absence. If not within the 2-hour mark, it is

considered a NO CALL NO SHOW. You will need to notify Mrs. Soliz or Mrs. Nuttall of your absence as well.

- If absent, you will be **REQUIRED to MAKEUP your community absence** with an assignment. Please try not to miss your community rotation as we work very hard to find sites for you to attend within the community.
- If you leave much earlier than what you are scheduled, send a quick text to Mrs. Nuttall or Mrs. Soliz informing us the site has let you leave early.
- Lunches- you may leave if site allows, just remember you are representing CSON and are in scrubs should you go in a public setting.
- You will provide an SLO example attached to your clinical paperwork.

OB ACUTE- MOM BABY, L&D, AP, NSY:

- We will meet in the CWC lobby. Please sit in the chairs near the elevators. Have your badge and make sure you have access to EPIC before clinical.
- **Have medication sheets filled out.** I will take these and review them and then return them to you so that you have access to them during your clinical. Students will do the corresponding medication sheet for the unit they are attending.
- **LD:** Students will be taken to the unit and will change into sterile scrubs (keep scrubs at the end of day; we will return them together.) Each student will be assigned to 1 nurse who only has 1 patient. You are to care for that patient until you relinquish care to the postpartum unit after delivery. We will review the electronic fetal & contraction strip together. ****Be active and engaged. Do not be afraid to ask to see procedures or deliveries while you wait for your patient to deliver. The worst they can say is no.****
- **MB:** Students will be taken to the unit and will be assigned to 1 nurse who has approximately 3 patients. **Choose 1 patient to do your paperwork.** You will provide care for **all** the nurse's patients: vital signs, medication administration, etc. The MB nurses will do a baseline assessment on each of their patients and newborns. Follow along. **Once you have completed paperwork and feel like you and your patient are ready, you will perform your own assessment on the mother.** *If you have 12 o'clock vitals, we can cluster care and do the assessment at the same time.* Do not stress!! I will review one on

one on how to do your assessment and follow up on how to improve your assessment for CPE.

- If you are sitting at the nurse's station and see a newborn being rolled to the nursery, ask to go to the nursery to see the NB procedures.
- Around 1330, I will gather all students, and together we will go to the Chili Parlor on the 6th floor for post conference. In post conference, everyone will give me SBAR, what skills you witnessed or performed & an example or two of what SLO you met (you will still write these down and turn them in, but I want to ensure that you are on the right track for meeting your SLO).
- You can turn paperwork to me in post conference or turn it into the "OB-CWC" dropbox. Please do not forget to turn it in before 1159 on Thursday.

STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Clinical Judgement, Communication & Collaboration, Patient Centered Care, Professionalism & Safety/Quality

- You are expected to provide an example of a student learning outcome **EVERY clinical week**.
- You need to provide *at least one example* of each of the student learning outcomes. While you can do all five for each week, you are still required to provide 1 SLO example each week. Keep track of what SLOs you have provided.
- By the end of OB clinical rotation, you will have provided an **example of ALL 5** student learning outcomes.
- **LABEL** what student learning outcome you are describing on your paperwork for SIM. **PRINT** the SLO sheet and write down your example for clinical and community. Each rotation will have its own sheet.

OB LAB INFORMATION:

- By the end of the 2nd week of OB clinical, we will know what you need to complete and will email you a reminder about what examples to look out for on that final week of OB clinical.
