CLINICAL JUDGEMENT- BY OBTAINING PATIENTS (SUBJECTIVE INFORMATION), WE PREPARED STD TESTING BY DRAWING BLOOD AND URINE TESTING.

PROFESSIONALISM- STD CLINIC MAINTAINED STRICT CONFIDENTIALITY BY USING PRIVATE ROOMS AND DID NOT DISCUSS IT W/CO-WORKERS. I NOTICED THEY PROVIDED NON-JUDGEMENTAL CARE BY BEING RESPECTFUL, AND THEY WERE EMPATHETIC AND WERE SO ATTENTIVE AND WERE ACTIVELY LISTENING TO THE PATIENT.

COMMUNICATION & COLLABORATION-THE NURSES USED NON-JUDGEMENTAL THERAPUTIC COMMUNICATION, EXPLAINING TO PATIENT HOW THE PROCEDURES (STD TESTING) USING SIMPLE AND CLEAR LANGUAGE. THEY USED OPEN-ENDED QUESTIONS AND PROVIDED GOOD EDUCATION. NURSES ALSO COLLABORATE WITH NURSE PRACTITIONER IF THEY HAD QUESTIONS.
