Nausea is common during IV therapy, may be relieved 2. Report any itching or rash of therapy 3. Inform if you experience trouble with breathing or difficulty 4. Allergic reaction to the drug is possible
<u>Codeine</u>				<u>Yes</u>	<u>TSINGIACTID</u>		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Don't use if pt has kidney problems 2. Watch for drowsiness or keep pt sedated 3. Only use when ordered by doctor 4. Use proper nursing assessment
