

## Instructional Module 6: Obstetrics Community Clinical Experience

Community Site: Parkridge Pregnancy

1. What did you observe during the day? Were there any specific procedures that were able to participate in or observe?  
I watched a urine hcg pregnancy test. There was a patient that had chlamydia, BV, CV, + a UTI all at the same time. I felt so bad for her... The youngest patient to come in was 14 y/o. She was still deciding if she was going to have an abortion in New Mexico or not. Other than that it was pretty slow.
2. What was the best/most interesting part of the experience?  
The best part was knowing what meds were given for each condition. Chlamydia → Azithromycin; BV → metronidazole  
Also being able to transfer class content into the clinical setting.
3. Is a community nursing position something that you would consider working in? Why or why not?  
I enjoyed today + even though OB isn't where I see myself working, I can see myself keeping an open mind about working in the community sites. The nurses were so sweet + you can see first hand that they care about all aspects of the patient without judgement.
4. Do you feel like this community site met the needs of the population they serve? Why or why not?  
Yes, they offer so many services, resources, + information free of charge. Based on today, the population served was young girls. Education + emotional support were high priority. Parkridge even has an entire wall dedicated to serves available in Lubbock.
5. Did you witness patient teaching? What general things were taught to this population? Do you feel that patient teaching in this community site was adequate? Why or why not?  
Education was primarily about places to contact + medication. Where to get them, how to take, when to take, benefits, side effects, etc. Teaching was adequate + they gave each patient written instructions to take home as well. The communication was individualized, easy to understand, + presented in a non-judgemental way. Education was given to every patient + support person (if present).
