

# Evidence-Based Practice (EBP) Group Project

## Project Overview

- **Purpose:** Introduce nursing students to EBP principles while reinforcing essential clinical skills.
- **Format:** Group PowerPoint presentation (7 slides minimum, 5–7 minutes).
- **Group Size:** 3–5 students per group.
- **Sources:** Minimum of 2 scholarly sources (within the past **five** years)
  - **Peer reviewed journal articles**, articles from **nursing or medical journal** are required.
- **APA Style: Follow APA guidelines.** Use APA 7th edition for references.
- **Visuals:** Include charts, diagrams, or images.
- **Professionalism and Teamwork:** \*You will be submitting peer reviews that are incorporated into your final grade
  - Be sure to split the workload equally and utilize each other's strengths.
- One student from each group should upload your presentation to Dropbox in LMS by 0800 the day of presentations.

## Slide-by-Slide Guidelines

Slide #	Title	Content
1	Title Slide	<b>Project title/EBP heading, group member names, module/course, &amp; date.</b>
2	Introduction to the Topic	Briefly explain why this skill or practice is important in nursing. Include 1–2 statistics or facts about the problem your topic addresses.
3	EBP Findings	Summary of 1–2 scholarly sources that support your topic. Include what the <b>research says about why this practice is effective.</b>
4	Application to Nursing Practice	Describe <b>how this EBP is applied in real nursing practice.</b> Include <b>steps, proper techniques, or scenarios</b> where it's used.
5	Ethical and Legal Considerations	Identify <b>ethical and legal risks</b> related to patient/nurse on your topic. (What interventions could the nurse potentially do to decrease the ethical and legal considerations.)
6	Fun/Interesting Fact	Include a memorable or surprising fact about your topic. (Example: "The first handwashing campaign was in the 1840s and reduced maternal deaths by 90%.")
7	References	Provide an APA 7th edition reference list for your sources. <b>Include at least 2 scholarly or professional sources.</b>

# PowerPoint Presentation Reminders

## Text & Font

- **Headings:** Use **32–44 pt** font size for slide titles.
- **Body Text:** Use **24–28 pt** font size for content.
- **Font Style:** Choose clean, readable fonts (e.g., Arial, Calibri, Verdana).
- **Contrast:** Ensure high contrast between text and background.

## Slide Content

- **Keep it concise:** Aim for **3–5 bullet points per slide**.
- **Avoid paragraphs:** Use short phrases or keywords.
- **Limit text:** No more than **6–8 lines per slide**.

## Visuals & Graphics

- Use **relevant images, charts, or diagrams** to support your message.
- Ensure visuals are **high-quality and properly cited** if needed.
- Avoid clutter—**one graphic per slide** is usually enough.

## Design & Layout

- Maintain a **consistent layout and color scheme**.
- Use **slide transitions sparingly** to avoid distraction.
- Align text and images neatly for a professional look.

## Presentation Delivery

- Practice to stay within the **5–7 minute time limit**.
- Speak clearly and confidently; **each group member should participate**.
- Use **notes or cue cards** if needed, but avoid reading slides verbatim.

## Citations & References

- Include **in-text citations** for any data or quotes.
- End with a **reference slide in APA 7th edition format**.
