

## Instructional Module 1 ATI Assignments

**Learning Objective:** To provide IM3 students opportunities to enhance nursing judgment, connecting theory to practice using Evidence Based Practice learning materials.

**Instructions:** Students must complete the weekly ATI learning activities as outlined in the ATI Assignment Calendar and the table below.
