

Instructional Module 1 ATI Assignments

Learning Objective: To provide IM1 students opportunities to enhance nursing judgment, connecting theory to practice using Evidence Based Practice learning materials.

Instructions: Students must complete the weekly ATI learning activities as outlined in the ATI Assignment Calendar and the table below.

Due Dates: ATI assignments are due on Monday by 11:59 pm/2359 on Weeks 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 (SEE COURSE CALENDAR and ATI Calendar). **Failure to complete each weekly assignment in its entirety by the specified date/time will result in a zero (0) in the Gradebook.**

Grading Criteria: *You must achieve a score of 80% on each ATI test or quiz listed to meet the IM1 course requirement. Lesson assignments require evidence of time spent and interaction with any questions, prompts, etc. contained in the lesson.* All post-lesson quizzes must achieve a score of 80% or show completion as detailed above to receive weekly credit for ATI. Students are **not required to complete EHR documentation embedded in the lessons until the week of the IM1 Documentation Lecture.** From the week of the IM1 Documentation Lecture until the end of IM1, each EHR activity in ATI lessons must be completed. **The ATI assignments count as 5% of your overall course grade.**

If a student sees a discrepancy between the instructor's reported grade and ATI completion, they must provide evidence via their student ATI transcript.
