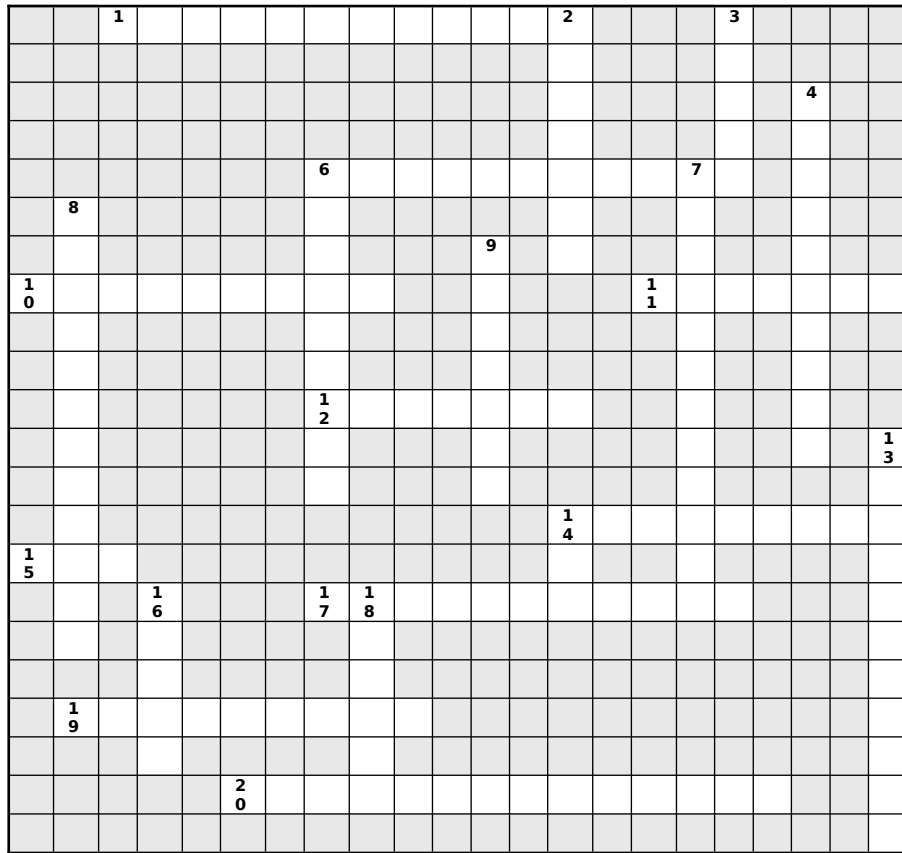

| 1 Communicable disease characterized by white then red “strawberry” tongue                 | 2 Communicable disease which is the greatest threat to an unborn baby                               |
| 6 Permanent contraindication to any vaccine                                                | 3 Interventions for this communicable disease include soft/liquid foods and warm or cool compresses |
| 10 Temporary contraindication to a live virus vaccine                                      | 4 Produced by the immune system in response to a vaccine                                            |
| 11 Vitamin A supplementation may be recommended for a child with this disease              | 6 Treatment for immunocompromised patients diagnosed with varicella                                 |
| 12 Used to stimulate the body’s immune response against diseases                           | 7 Process by which a person becomes protected against disease through vaccination                   |
| 14 Communicable disease characterized by a vesicular rash which is extremely pruritic      | 8 Spread of disease is stopped when the majority of the population is vaccinated                    |
| 15 Vaccine responsible for decreased cases of bacterial meningitis in children             | 9 Type of immunity when antibodies are transferred from an animal or human to another human         |
| 17 Most effective prevention method for controlling the spread of any communicable disease | 13 Type of vaccine which cannot replicate                                                           |
| 19 Disease with respiratory assessment as a priority                                       | 14 Required by law to be given with each dose of vaccine                                            |
| 20 Vaccines which are a weakened form of the “wild” virus or bacterium                     | 16 National surveillance system for vaccine safety                                                  |
