Medication	Route	Common Adult Dose	Typical Frequency														
Pantoprazole	PO	40 mg	Once daily														
Sodium Chloride 0.9%	IV	150 mL/hr	Maintenance: continuous														
Metoprolol Tartrate	PO	50 mg	Twice daily (BID)														
Furosemide	PO	40 mg	Once daily														
Potassium Chloride	PO	20 mEq	Once daily														
Acetaminophen	PO	1000 mg	Every 4-6 hours PRN; max 3,000-4,000 mg/day														
Morphine Sulfate	IV	2-4 mg	Every 2-4 hours PRN pain														
Milk of Magnesia	PO	60 mL	Once daily PRN														
Insulin Lispro (Humalog)	SQ	10 units & SS	With meals (AC) and/or sliding scale
