Do not exceed over 3,000mg/day 3. Does not contain anti-inflammatory effects 4. Early signs and symptoms of overdose is N/V and diaphoresis

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Ondansetron	antiemetic	N/V	4mg q6 PRN	Yes	NA	Prolonged QT interval, serotonin syndrome, Headache, constipation, diarrhea, fatigue	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> do not crush, split, or chew assess/monitor bowel sounds, and prolonged QT report immediately if there are any signs of an allergic reaction such as a rash, hives, or difficulty breathing can be taken with or without food
Piperacillin-tazobactam (Zosyn)	antibiotic	Bacterial infections	3.375g IVPB q6	Yes	IVPB- sodium chloride 0.9%, 100mL, 200mL/hr-15 minutes	Diarrhea, constipation, trouble sleeping	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Assess and monitor- S/S of worsening infection, WBC, Diarrhea watch for hypersensitivity reactions such as rash, urticaria, wheezing, facial swelling, and anaphylaxis signs of a superinfection include oral thrush and severe or persistent diarrhea. monitor IV site for patency, redness, swelling, and pain
