Patient Centered Care:

I was able to witness Pt centered care when a Pt came in wanting information on pregnancy & information about abortion. The nurse asked numerous questions & realized Pt was on the spectrum. Did not know how to express her feelings. The nurse was able to teach about what happens during the abortion but was able to get social worker involved to help w/ her mental health needs during the abortion. The nurse even asked if her boyfriend needed to talk to someone to help w/ his feelings on the abortion.

Communication & Collaboration:

The professionalism at this facility was amazing. I realized that you have to look at every case opened minded & not to judge because you don't know what they are going through. The Pt who came in wanting an abortion now she was pregnant but continued to do drugs & alcohol. Pt informed she was on the spectrum stressed from losing her job & home. Pt reported she wanted to rear the baby but knew the outcome would be worse for the baby, because of everything going on. The nurse remained professional & kept an open mind. The nurse was compassionate & provide options to help the Pt's needs, w/out her own judgment getting involved.
