GROUP ACTIVITY PRESENTATION REVIEW  
BLEND IT!



Objectives:

At the end of this activity, the YES! Student will be able to:

- 1) Identify their personality traits and sub-traits.
- 2) Show how the combination of personality traits and sub-traits can strengthen or alter behavioural tendencies.

If this activity is chosen, the students will soon realise they have been looking at individual Personality Traits. Obviously, no one is just representative of one Personality Trait. Each person has a blend of all six Personality pair traits.

Some traits 'blend' well together and make each other stronger. Some act as a balancer, helping to make the trait less influential. This activity will help the student to understand the 'combined recipe' of their unique design.

Method:

- 1) Divide the group into smaller groups using their strongest Personality Trait.
- 2) Watch the power point presentation and have a short discussion with the children around what is expected of them.
- 3) List what you what you will put in your blender. Use your strongest Personality and its sub-traits. Write them onto your sticky note and put it into the blender. Do the same thing with your next two Personality Traits, writing them on sticky notes too. If you want to add anymore traits or sub-traits draw more sticky notes.
- 4) Choose the type of milkshake that you think would represent your personality the best. Or choose the blank Milkshake template and colour and decorate your Milkshake as you like. Candy, cream, cherries anything that makes your Milkshake exciting and like you. Whatever, your choice, in the sticky notes, write how you see your Personality Traits working together.
- 5) Confirm and encourage each child's Milkshake mix before releasing them.

Materials, Supply's and Requirements:

Suitable venue.

Electronic equipment and screen.

Crayons, writing materials, glue, scissors, all sorts of decoration materials.

Copies of the Milkshake template.
