Improvising	Unstructured	To invent, compose, or perform with little or no preparation.
Ambitious	Adventurous	Full of, characterized by, or motivated by ambition. Requiring or showing much effort; challenging. Having a strong desire for success or achievement, necessitating extraordinary effort or ability, having a great desire; eager.
Indifferent	Unstructured	Having no particular interest or concern; apathetic. Having no marked feeling for or against. Showing no care or concern; uninterested
Clever	Innovative	Mentally quick and original; bright. These adjectives refer to mental adroitness or to practical ingenuity and skill. Clever is the most comprehensive. Displaying sharp intelligence or mental alertness.
Distant	Introversion	Far apart in relationship and mentally, aloof or chilly.
Quiet	Introversion	Making little or no noise. Free of loud noise; hushed. Calm and unmoving, still. Free of turmoil and agitation; untroubled. Restful; soothing. Restrained in style, understated

Imaginative	Innovative	Having a lively imagination, especially a creative imagination. Created by, indicative of, or characterized by imagination or creativity. Tending to indulge in the fanciful or in make-believe.
Objective	Detachment	Uninfluenced by emotions or personal prejudices. Based on observable phenomena; presented factually.

Neutral	Detachment	Not aligned with, supporting, or favoring either side in a war, dispute, or contest. Belonging to neither side in a controversy.
Verbal	Extroversion	Relating to, or using words, as opposed to ideas, etc. Oral rather than written.
Independent	Dominance	Not governed by a foreign power; self-governing. Free from the influence, guidance, or control of another or others; self-reliant.
Organized	Conscientious	Functioning within a formal structure, as in the coordination and direction of activities. Efficient and methodical. Planned and controlled on a large scale and involving many people. Orderly and efficient.
Content	Cautious	Desiring no more than what one has; satisfied. Ready to accept or acquiesce; willing. Mentally or emotionally satisfied with things as they are. Assenting to or willing to accept circumstances, a proposed course of action, etc. Peace of mind; mental or emotional satisfaction.
Conforming	Compliance	To correspond in form or character; be similar. To act or be in accord or agreement; comply

Consumer Science

Definition: Activities for this group are menu planning, catering, decorating, hair styling and personal care.

Potential Occupation: Consumer sciences teacher, homemaker, dietitian, beautician (hair stylist), etc.

Religious

Definition: Centers on activities like providing spiritual or religious guidance and listening to others' personal problems.

Potential Occupation: Pastor, reverend, missionary, biblical counselor, etc.

Technical Science

Definition: Has strong desire to plan, design, and be involved in the construction of buildings, roads, airports, and structures that require a high level of technology.

Potential Occupation: Engineer, architect, drafter, etc.

Athletic

Definition: Strong interest in athletic pursuits.

Potential Occupation: Personal trainer, coach, ^{professional} athlete, physical education teacher, umpire, etc.

Customer Service

Definition: Helping visitors, callers, customers, guests, etc. when they need help, information and or assistance.

Potential Occupation: customer service representative, receptionist, restaurant server, bank teller, hotel clerk, etc.

Interpersonal: People skills are a natural strength. Ability to communicate effectively and your strong interest in people will naturally generate opportunities to counsel, teach and explain.

Management: Ability to excel at coordinating the activities of others, and to persuade and motivate others.

Organizational: Typically excel at assembling, storing, and retrieving information, data, and items in a systematic fashion.

Athletic: High level of physical coordination, athletic skills, hand-eye coordination, and a deep desire to compete.

Musical: Typically have an innate ability to express rhythm, play musical instruments, interpret and express emotions or ideas vocally, understand musical symbols and theory, and differentiate qualities and pitches of tones.

Work Environment Values

Adventure: Likes to be where the action is even when it is somewhat risky. Motivated by experiencing adventure and working with the unknown and unexpected.

Challenge: Needs the opportunity to solve tough problems and work "make or break" issues. Looks for difficult assignments and obstacles to overcome. Controversy is not a problem. Restores order where there is chaos.

Work Outcome Values

High Income: Values being highly rewarded financially for efforts at work. Believes a high-income level is a factor needed to feel successful in work.

Helping Others: Contributing to the welfare and growth of others is important and should be an integral part of work.

Life Values

Aesthetics: Artistic expression and creativeness are high priorities. Enjoys being involved in activities that make life more beautiful, where emotional sensitivity can be used, and where creative views and talents can be expressed freely.

Integrity: Honesty is a top value. Makes every effort to keep commitments and live by the highest standard of fairness and truth.
