A couple pieces of information before I specify my recommendation. My client specified that her dream job is to be an architect or professor, and I also know she has a lot of skill surrounding plants and gardening as during her childhood she had lots of outdoors gardening/agricultural experience. She has a lot of plant knowledge. She also has thought about opening a clothing shop that sells only white clothes, since she has had a problem finding good white clothes.

I plan to take her through measuring her ideas of Architect/Urban designer, Professor, and business owner of a white shirt shop against her personality, interests, skills, and values. I currently plan interviewing my client more about her desire to be an architect and ask about the specific desires and appeals of being an architect to her. Depending on the things that she desires about being an architect, I'd recommend traditional architecture OR an urban designer. More specifically an urban designer that specializes in planning the landscaping (flowers, trees, how the nature/gardens are going to be laid out.) The reason for these being my primary recommendations is it matches personality, specifically capitalizing on her high level of BOTH imaginative and clever subfactors. There is a match along her interests as she specifically said she desires to be an architect, she has high scores in landscaping and artistic, and these paths could incorporate those. They also make great use of analytical, her #1 skill. Her #1 work outcome value is high income, and for me this is another reason these recommendations make more sense than her other dream job of professor. I could see her being a professor as a more retirement job. Her idea of owning a white clothing business is something that doesn't directly contrast against her design, however I think architecture or urban design could capitalize more on her imaginative/clever personality trait.
