**I. Course Description**

An in-depth study of the Biblical teaching of separation, both ecclesiastical and personal.

**II. Course Objectives**

As a result of taking this class, the student should be able to:

- A. Understand the biblical doctrines of ecclesiastical and personal separation and how to apply them to his life and ministry.
- B. Defend these doctrines from those who disparage them.
- C. Articulate these doctrines so that believers to whom he ministers will be encouraged to live by them.

- B. Class work:** This course consists of 15 recorded classes, 15 lessons and 6 tests all of which are online.
- C. Bible Memorization:** At the end of each lesson the student is given Bible verses to memorize which may be required on the test.

**IV. Tests & Grading:**

A test will be given after every second lesson for a total of 6 tests. The tests are graded on a scale of 0-100. A grade of 80% or higher is considered passing. The final grade for the course is the average of the grades on the 6 tests.
