I. Course Description

This course will cover several types of phonics training in order to prepare the student for a variety of church school settings. The three main areas of emphasis will be: traditional phonics, ACE phonics, and phonics for the academically challenged.

II. Course Objectives

As a result of taking this class, the student should be able to demonstrate an understanding of:

- A. The characteristics of effective and ineffective teaching.
- B. The goals and objectives of different phonics systems.
- C. The rules and guidelines that allow for successful phonetic reading.

III. Course Requirements

- A. **Class work:** There are 21 lectures for this course. As there are no pre-made Study Packs, the student is expected to make his own notes. There are 8 tests to be taken at predetermined points in the course.

IV. Tests & Grading

The tests will be graded on a percentage basis with 80% the minimum score for a passing grade. Scores less than 80% will require the student to repeat the lessons pertaining to the test.
