I. Course Description

II. Course Objectives

III. Course Requirements

IV. Tests & Grading

Testing consists of two written essays and a written Final Exam.

The essay tests will be graded on a percentage basis with 80% the minimum score for a passing grade. A score of less than 80% will require the student to repeat the lessons pertaining to the test.

Essay tests will be graded based upon doctrinal accuracy, logical cohesion, and the student's ability to demonstrate their understanding of the course material.
