I. Course Description

An analytical study of the book of Acts showing the biblical foundations of the early development of Christianity. Particular attention is paid to the transition from Israel to the Church and Paul's missionary journeys.

II. Course Objectives

As a result of taking this class, the student should be able to demonstrate an understanding of:

- A.** The events and spiritual ramifications of the book of Acts.
- B.** The people, places, and events of the book of Acts.
- C.** The dispensational change from Israel to the Church.

III. Course Requirements

A. Required Reading:
The *Books of Acts*.

B. Class work: There are 30 lectures associated with 30 self-directed study packs for this course. The student is expected to listen to the lectures, answer the Study Pack questions, and confirm the accuracy of their answers. Tests should be taken according to the Test Schedule.
