### I. Course Description

This is an examination of the case for biblical Christianity. It presents facts on the existence of God, internal and external proofs that the Bible is God's Word, and the history of the Sacred Canon.

### II. Course Objectives

As a result of taking this class, the student should be able to:

- A. Define 'apologetics'.
- B. Outline the different apologetic systems and arguments.
- C. Explain how logical thought processes and concepts relate to apologetics.
- D. Explain the uniqueness of the resurrection of Jesus Christ and how the resurrection verifies Christianity.

### III. Course Requirements

- A. **Class work:** There are 14 self-directed study packs and lectures for this course. The student is expected to listen to the lectures, answer the Study Pack questions, and confirm the accuracy of their answers. Tests should be taken according to the Test Schedule.
- B. **Bible Memorization:** Specific Bible Verses must be memorized for each test. See the Test Schedule for more details.

### IV. Tests & Grading

The tests will be graded on a percentage basis with 80% the minimum score for a passing grade. Scores less than 80% will require the student to repeat the lessons pertaining to the test.
