I. Course Description

A study of the book of Matthew. This course examines the historical context of Jesus' ministry, Matthew's focus of Jesus as the Messiah, the presentation of the Messianic kingdom, and the prophetic foreshadowing of future events.

II. Course Objectives

As a result of taking this class, the student should be able to:

- A.** Explain the nature of Matthew's Gospel and how it relates to the Jewish people.
- B.** Detail the prophecies that Matthew cites as proof of Jesus' being the Messiah.
- C.** Know and demonstrate how the words of Jesus Christ, as recorded in Matthew, pertain to the end times and future events.

III. Course Requirements

A. Required Reading:

The Gospel According to Matthew.

- B. Class work:** There are 28 lectures relating to 28 self-directed Study Packs for this course. Each Study Pack corresponds to one chapter in the Gospel according to Matthew. The student is expected to listen to the lectures, answer the Study Pack questions, and confirm the accuracy of their answers. Tests should be taken according to the Test Schedule.

IV. Tests & Grading

The tests will be graded on a percentage basis with 80% the minimum score for a passing grade. Scores less than 80% will require the student to repeat the lessons pertaining to the test.
