Brachial:

- Blood pressure measurements
- Infant during CPR

Radial:

- Most commonly used pulse site, would be my go to first option.

Ulnar:

- Check circulation of the arm

Dorsalis Pedis:

- Check foot circulation

Temporal:

- While monitoring cranial circulation

Carotid:

- During emergencies
- During CPR

Apical:

- Assess with a stethoscope for a minute before the use of Digoxin, a heart medication

Femoral:

- Check circulation of the legs

Popliteal:

- Check circulation to legs and feet

Posterior Tibial:

- While monitoring foot circulation
