Explain the importance of this rule to patient safety and positive patient outcomes. I chose rule (E) This rule states that is our duty as an RN to question that is not properly written or is missing information, or just doesn't even pertain to our patient diagnosis or signs and symptoms we should question it. Or if an order for our patient isn't written by any doctors or staff not working as their care team should be questioned and verify by the proper people. If the order contradicts the patient in any way and will result in causing harm to the patient should be questioned by the nurse and brought to the doctors attention. All orders that the as the nurse you have questions about should be clarified by the doctor or which ever team member wrote the order. Such as the PT, OT, ST or Physician or Psychiatrist.
