1. How many new HIV infections were diagnosed in Erie County during 2021?

In 2021, 6 new HIV infections were diagnosed in Erie County.

2. How many total new HIV infections were diagnosed in Ohio during 2021?
 - a. Total # of cases: A total of 912 new diagnoses occurred in Ohio.

b. # of male cases: There are 707 male cases in 2021.

c. # of female cases: There are 205 females with HIV in Ohio in 2021.

3. What 6 counties in Ohio had the most new HIV infections diagnosed during 2021? Include the # of cases for each county.

1. Franklin- 188
2. Cuyahoga – 165
3. Hamilton- 124
4. Montgomery County- 60
5. Butler County-67
6. Summit County- 46
