<b>CNS Depressants</b>	Relaxation, loss of inhibitions, lack of concentration, slurred speech, drowsiness	Nausea, vomiting, aggressiveness, impaired judgement and attention, slurred speech, unsteady gait	Tremors, nausea/vomiting, tachycardia, elevated BP, seizures, hallucinations, irritability
<b>CNS Stimulants</b>	Hyperactivity, agitation, euphoria, insomnia, loss of appetite	Tachycardia, pupil dilation, elevated BP, diaphoresis, nausea/vomiting	Anxiety, depressed mood, irritability, craving, paranoia, suicidal ideation, impaired sleep patterns
<b>Opioids</b>	Euphoria, lethargy, lack of motivation, constricted pupils	Euphoria, lethargy, pupil constriction, slurred speech, decreased respiratory rate and BP	Craving, nausea/vomiting, muscle aches, pupil dilation, sweating, diarrhea, fever, insomnia
<b>Hallucinogens</b>	Visual hallucinations, disorientation, confusion, euphoria, anxiety, increased heart rate	Psychosis, agitation, increased HR BP, muscle rigidity, seizures, delirium	Classical-do not withdraw dissociative (PCP, K)-hallucinations, seizures, acidosis, fear
<b>Cannabinols</b>	Relaxation, talkativeness, lowered inhibitions, euphoria, mood swings	Euphoria, anxiety, impaired judgment, sense of slowed time, conjunctiva redness, increased appetite, hallucinations	Restlessness, irritability, insomnia, loss of appetite, depressed mood, fever, chills, headache, stomach pain
<b>Inhalants</b>	Apathy, decrease of appetite and weight loss, slurred speech, tiredness, ulcers around nose and mouth	Belligerence, impaired judgement, nystagmus, slurred speech, unsteady gait, tremor, coma, ENT irritation	Anxiety, nausea, tremors, irritability, agitation, diaphoresis, tachycardia, hallucinations, psychosis
