- Temporal- Used to determine factors based on vision or headaches.
- Carotid- Usually use to determine if CPR is necessary.
- Apical- Used to evaluate how well the heart is functioning.
- Brachial- Used to assess blood pressure.
- Radial- Easy to access where a clear pulse is evident.
- Ulnar- Used if the radial pulse is not sufficient.
- Femoral- Determine blood supply of lower body.
- Popliteal- Determine the blood flow of an even lower area of the body.
- Posterior Tibial- Determines blood flow in that region.
- Dorsalis Pedis- Could determine the presence of disease.
