

Pulse Site Assignment



1. **Temporal**-As an RN one would use this pulse site because it is an easily accessible site which is used to assess for pulse in children.
2. **Carotid**-As an RN one would use this site because it is easily accessible in patients with physiological shock or during adult CPR when other sites are not palpable.
3. **Apical**-As an RN one would use this pulse site to auscultate for apical pulse.
4. **Brachial**- As an RN one would use this site because it is used to assess upper-extremity blood pressure. The brachial site would be used during infant CPR.
5. **Radial**-As an RN one would use this site because it is used to assess character of pulse peripherally. This site is used to assess the status of circulation to hand.
6. **Ulnar**-As an RN one would use this site because it is used to assess the status of circulation to ulnar side of hand. This site would be used for an Allen test.
7. **Femoral**-As an RN one would use this site because it is used to assess the status of circulation to one's leg. One uses this site to assess the pulse in patients with physiological shock or during CPR when other pulses are not palpable.
8. **Popliteal**-As an RN one would use this site to auscultate lower-extremity blood pressure. One can use this site to assess the circulation to lower leg.

9. **Posterior Tibial**-As an RN one would use this site to assess the status of circulation to the foot.

10. **Dorsalis Pedis**- As an RN one would use this site to assess the status of circulation to the foot.
