Apical – site used for taking apical pulse.

Brachial – used for upper-body blood pressure or for infant CPR.

Carotid – used when there is physiological shock or adult CPR if other locations are unavailable.

Dorsalis pedis – used to find status of foot circulation.

Femoral Popliteal – used to find status of circulation to the leg.

Posterior Tibial – used to find status of circulation of foot.

Temporal – find a pulse in children.

Ulnar – used to perform Allen tests.
