TeamSTEPPS is Team Strategies and Tools to Enhance Performance and Patient Safety. It is a set of teamwork tools aimed at optimizing patient outcomes, improve the quality, safety, and the efficiency of healthcare.

**2. What are the key skills of TeamSTEPPS? Briefly explain each.**

**Communication-** A verbal and nonverbal that can be clearly and accurately exchanged among team members.

**Team Leadership-** ensuring that team actions are understood, changes in information are shared, and team members have the necessary resources.

**Situation Monitoring-**to gain information or understanding, or to maintain awareness to support team functioning.

**Mutual Support-** support team members' needs through accurate knowledge about their workload.

**3. What are the responsibilities of an effective team leader?**

The responsibilities are to organize the team, identify and articulate clear goals Assign tasks and responsibilities, monitor, and modify the plan of care. Verify that the task is being performed to the standards of practice. Evaluate the performance of the task. Delegation, motivate team members, resolve conflict, and goal setting. The team leader should be able to ensure smooth team operations and effective collaboration.
