TeamSTEPPS is Team Strategies & Tools to Enhance Performance and Patient Safety. A model to help promote healthy team relationships, good communication and effective leadership.

team leadership- Ability to lead teams and team members understand information shared,
situation monitoring- always assess and monitor situations to gain helpful information, and
